Required Immunizations:

Colorado law requires anyone who is enrolled for one or more classes at a college or university and who is physically present at the institution to meet the following immunization requirements:

1. **Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) Vaccine:** All students born after December 31, 1956 must submit proof of **two (2) valid doses of MMR vaccine**. The first MMR dose cannot be counted if given earlier than four days before the student's first birthday, and the second dose must have been given at least 28 days after the first dose.

Alternatively, a student can submit laboratory proof of immunity. The laboratory test result(s) must show range of immunity. CSU Health Network will not accept documentation by a doctor or parent stating that a student had the disease(s).

2. **Meningococcal (ACWY) Vaccine:** All students **living on campus in student housing** must provide proof of a Meningococcal (ACWY) vaccine received **within the last five (5) years**.

Alternatively, students can read and sign a waiver titled "Information Regarding Meningococcal Disease" by calling the CSU Health Network Immunizations Department at (970) 491-7121 and requesting online access to the form through the CSU Student Health Portal.

Note: If students cannot verify their immunizations, they can be re-immunized or tested for immunity with an MMR titer blood test at the on-campus CSU Health Network Immunizations Department. Medical, religious, and personal exemptions are allowed by law.

Additional Recommended Immunizations: Refer to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for a list of recommended vaccines based on your age, job, lifestyle, travel and health conditions at www.cdc.gov/vaccines/adults/rec-vac. CSU Health Network Immunizations Department can administer these immunizations to students.

Instructions for completing the New Student Immunizations Requirement:

Immunization records are submitted online through the CSU Student Health Portal.

1. Make sure you have your official immunization record in a digital format no larger than 3 MB. The record must contain student name, student date of birth, and student CSU ID number. If you do not have official documentation or a single page document, consider having your health care provider complete the one-page form on the reverse side of this document.
2. Log in to the CSU Student Health Portal at portal.health.colostate.edu with your CSU ID eName and password.
3. Click on "Document Upload" in the navigation menu. Select "Immunization Record" in the Document Type drop-down menu and read the instructions. Click the "Browse" button and select your digital immunization record file. Click the "Save" button to submit your document.
4. Click on "My Forms" in the navigation menu.
5. Click on "Immunization Dates" under Form Name.
6. Refer to your official immunization record and enter the dates of your MMR vaccine doses. Also enter the date of your meningococcal and Tdap vaccinations, if applicable.
7. Enter your electronic signature and click Submit.
8. If your submission is not compliant with the requirements, you will receive an email to your colostate.edu email address requesting additional information.

IMPORTANT: If requirement is not completed by the first day of classes of your first semester on campus, a **HOLD will be placed** on your student account that will prevent you from registering for classes the following semester until the requirement is met.

B. Required Immunizations

MMR Requirement: Two doses of measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccination are required. The first MMR cannot be accepted by the institute if it was given earlier than four days before the student's 1st birthday. The second dose of MMR must be given at least 28 days after the first dose of MMR. A positive MMR titer result may be submitted in lieu of vaccination history (attach copy of titer result).

Meningococcal (ACWY) Requirement: All students living on campus in student housing must provide documentation of receiving a Meningococcal ACWY vaccine within the last 5 years, OR they must read and sign the "Information Regarding MENINGOCOCCAL DISEASE" online waiver (see page 1 of form instructions for information on how to access online form.)
