New Student Immunizations Form



Fall 2022 deadline: Monday, August 22, 2022

Spring 2022 deadline: Tuesday, January 18, 2022

Required Immunizations:

Colorado law requires anyone who is enrolled for one or more classes at a college or university and who is physically present at the institution to meet the following immunization requirements:

1. **Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) Vaccine:** All students born after December 31, 1956 must submit proof of **two (2) valid doses of MMR vaccine**. The first MMR dose cannot be counted if given earlier than four days before the student's first birthday, and the second dose must have been given at least 28 days after the first dose.

Alternatively, a student can submit laboratory proof of immunity. The laboratory test result(s) must show range of immunity. CSU Health Network will not accept documentation by a doctor or parent stating that a student had the disease(s).

2. **Meningococcal (ACWY) Vaccine:** All students **living on campus in a residence hall** must provide proof of a Meningococcal (ACWY) vaccine received **within the last five (5) years**.

Alternatively, students can read and sign a waiver titled "Information Regarding Meningococcal Disease" by calling the CSU Health Network Immunizations Department at (970) 491-7121 and requesting online access to the form through the CSU Student Health Portal.

IMPORTANT: If requirement is not completed by the first day of classes of your first semester on campus, a **HOLD will be placed on your student account that will prevent you from registering for classes the following semester until the requirement is met.**

Note: If students cannot verify their immunizations, they can be re-immunized or tested for immunity with an MMR titer blood test at the on-campus CSU Health Network Immunizations Department. Medical and nonmedical exemptions are allowed by law. For more information on MMR and Meningococcal (ACWY) vaccine exemptions, visit health.colostate.edu/new-student-checklist/#immunizations

3. **COVID-19 Vaccine:** CSU students must also submit COVID-19 vaccine records or declare an exemption. First-year students, new transfer students, and new graduate students should submit their COVID-19 vaccine record when completing the other new student immunization requirements. Additional Recommended Immunizations: Refer to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for a list of recommended vaccines based on your age, job, lifestyle, travel and health conditions at www.cdc.gov/vaccines/adults/rec-vac. CSU Health Network Immunizations Department can administer these immunizations to students.

Instructions for completing the New Student Immunizations Requirement:

Immunization records are submitted online through the CSU Student Health Portal at portal.health.colostate.edu.

Make sure you have your official immunizations record in a digital format. Full instructions for completing the New Student Immunizations Requirement can be found by using the QR code below or by visiting health.colostate.edu/new-student-checklist/#immunizations.

Please allow 2-3 weeks to process your records. After your records are processed, you will receive an email indicating that you have met the immunizations requirement, or requesting that you submit additional information in order to meet the requirement.
